Knit with one skein in one hour!

Yarn: Sari Ribbon, 50g: 1 skein

Needles: US sz 11 doublepoints (for knit round version) or
US sz 11 straights (for knit flat version)
US sz J crochet hook
(note: 3/4" or wider ribbon may work up best on
sz 13 needles)

Notions: yarn needle and cotton sewing thread in yarn
color, carabineer clip or metal binder clip

Gauge: 2.5 sts & 3 rows = 1" approx.

Measurements: 4" wide x 4.5" tall

Bag body

Note: if using sz 13 needles for wider ribbon, cast on two less sts.

Knit round version:

With doublepointed needles, CO 19 sts. Knit in the round
until piece measures approx 4" tall. Divide sts between needles and use a three-needle bind off to finish.

Knit flat version:

With straight needles, CO 19 sts. Work stockinette stitch
until piece measures approx 4" tall. Divide sts between needles and use a three-needle bind off to finish.

With right sides facing, use sewing thread doubled and yarn
needle to seam up side.

Hanging loop

Loop shown on rainbow colored pocket:

With crochet hook, chain a length approx 8.5" long.
Use sewing thread doubled to attach inside the back of the
pocket, in the center.

Strap shown on red colored pocket:

With crochet hook, chain a length approx 12.5" long.
Select a 4-5" long piece of metallic or contrasting color ribbon.
Fold the chained length in half and wrap the 4-5" long piece
of ribbon around the loop, 1" down from the top. Use sewing
thread to secure wrapped ribbon around loop. With sewing
thread doubled, sew either end of strap to inside sides of
pocket.
