Sari So: a triangle shawl

designed by Kassie Kaye



Yarn: Sari Ribbon : 4 hanks

Needles: US sz 36 needles

Notions: yarn needle

Gauge: 5 sts = 4"

Measurements: 70" long, 16" wide at the center

Difficulty: Beginner

Shawl

CO 2 sts. Purl one row. (WS)

Row 1: K 1, YO, knit to end of row

Row 2 & 4: Purl.

Row 3: K 1, YO, K2tog, knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 1-4 until 5 sts are on the needle.

Row 5: K 1, YO, knit to end of row.

Row 6: Purl.

Repeat rows 5 & 6 until 2 full hanks have been knit, ending with a WS row.

Row 7: K 1, YO, K2tog, knit to end of row.

Row 8: Purl to last 4 sts, p2tog, p 2.

continued below...

Repeat row 7 & 8 until 5 sts remain on the needle, ending with a WS row.

Row 9: K 1, YO, K2tog, knit to end of row.

Row 10: Purl.

Row 11: K 1, YO, K2tog, knit to end of row.

Row 12: Purl to last 4 sts, p2tog, p 2.

Repeat rows 9-12 until 2 sts remain on the needle.

Bind off. Weave in ends. Block if desired.

About Sari Ribbon:

Remnant silk fabrics are cut into strips and sewn end to end to create this wildly unique yarn. The result is a chunky, shiny ribbon with a fabulous mix of colors.

Sari Ribbon yarn is made for frabjous fibers by a group of women in India. By purchasing this yarn you help to make fair trade programs work!
